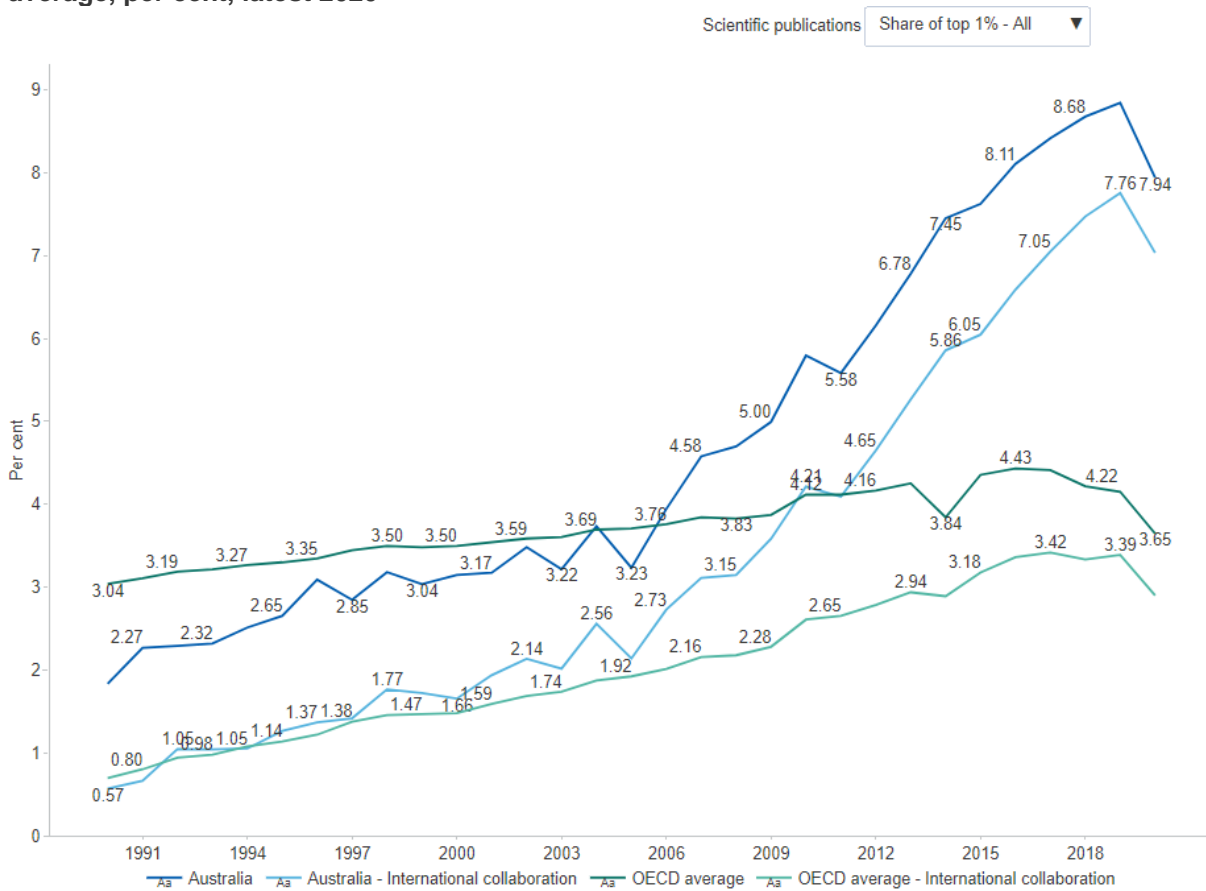


### 3.4.4 Share of top one and top ten per cent highly-cited publications

*Australia's* share of both top 1 per cent and top 10 per cent highly-cited publications has risen sharply since 2005, although there are some recent signs of a possible plateau in growth. In 2020, Australian authors were credited in 7.9 per cent of the world's top 1 per cent highly-cited publications and in 6.1 per cent of the world's top 10 per cent highly-cited publications for all disciplines. Further, while rates of international collaboration have risen around the world, *Australia* has experienced a greater increase in its publication citations involving international collaboration compared to the *OECD* average.<sup>1</sup>
